

**ORDINANCE NO. 17-05-09 A**

**AN AMENDMENT TO THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 06-03-27, SECTION 6-19 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE REGULATIONS); PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Mineola, Texas, has previously passed a comprehensive zoning plan by way of Ordinance No. 06-03-27; and

**WHEREAS**, the City now desires to amend Section 6-19 (Alcoholic Beverage Regulations) of said Zoning Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds said amendment to be in the best interest of its citizens to preserve the health, safety, and general welfare of its residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS AS FOLLOWS:**

**I.  
AMENDMENT**

Section 6-19 (Alcoholic Beverage Regulations) of Ordinance No. 06-03-27 is hereby amended as follows:

"The City of Mineola has passed Ordinance No. 11-04-11 providing regulations for alcoholic beverages. Ordinance No. 11-04-11 and all applicable amendments thereto are incorporated by reference within this Ordinance as if they were fully set forth herein."

**II.  
SEVERABILITY**

Should any clause, phrase, sentence or section of this Ordinance be declared illegal, invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such finding shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance

**III.  
REPEALER**

All provisions in any ordinance, resolution, motion or regulation of the City of Mineola in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict. Any and all remaining portions of conflicting ordinances, resolutions, motions and/or regulation shall remain in full force and effect.

**IV.  
EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
