

ORDINANCE NO. 17-11-27A

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 94-8-8, ARTICLE V, SECTION 6, AS CODIFIED IN ARTICLE III (ELECTRICAL CODE), DIVISION 2 (PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS), SECTION 8-78 AS CODIFIED IN THE MINEOLA CITY; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Mineola previously passed Ordinance No. 94-8-8, setting forth guidelines regarding the authorization for electrical connections concerning structures located within the Mineola city limits; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 94-8-8 was codified in the Mineola Municipal Code as Article III, Division 2, Section 8-78; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mineola now desires to amend the above-referenced Section to add additional regulations concerning electrical connections and inspections.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINEOLA, TEXAS, ARTICLE III, DIVISION 2, SECTION 8-78 OF THE MINEOLA CODE OF ORDINANCES IS AMENDED TO ADD SUBSECTION (B) TO SECTION 8-78 AS FOLLOWS:

**I.
AMENDMENT**

Sec. 8-78(b) Any and all authorized inspector(s) of the City shall have the right to conduct an inspection of any structure the subject of this Code in the event of a change in the customer(s) account name regarding a City provided utility servicing such structure. Should a structure be found to be non-compliant following such an inspection, any and all third-party electric utility providers servicing the structure shall be notified of the non-compliant status of the structure. In such an event, the City shall direct a third-party electric utility provider to discontinue service to the structure until such time as code compliance is obtained, at which time any and all third-party electric utility providers shall be notified and service may be provided accordingly.

**II.
SEVERABILITY**

Should any phrase, sentence, clause, or provision of this Ordinance be declared illegal, be held unconstitutional, invalid, or of no force or effect, such findings shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

III.
REPEALER

Any ordinance, resolution, or other regulation of the City of Mineola that is in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

IV.
EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the City Council of the City of Mineola.


