

**Miss Mineola Fire Department Rodeo
Jr Miss Mineola Fire Department Rodeo
Rules and Regulations**

1. Contestant Must:

1. Have been born a female.
2. Be a legal resident of the United States.
3. Be a student in good standing.
4. Not be or have been married, nor had a marriage nullified.
5. Not be or have been pregnant.
6. Have not been convicted of a misdemeanor or felony of any kind.
7. Live up to 200miles of Mineola TX.
8. Jr.Miss Division 10-15, Miss Division age 16-21 as of **July 11, 2019**

2. Any contestant currently holding a title may compete only if current title will be relinquished by **September 30, 2019** and also with proven consent from the board members of the current title.

3. All contestants will be responsible for \$75.00 early entry fee **by May 25, 2019** and 1 silent auction item \$15.00 minimum due by contest day. Late entry of \$100.00 will be due During **May 26- June 1, 2018**. The entry fee will be used for contest expenses and awards. All entry fees are nonrefundable.

4. All contestants will be responsible for their own transportation and will be required to have a horse on the grounds at all times during the rodeo.

5. Miss MFDR will receive a \$1000.00 scholarship and awards, Jr. Miss MFDR will receive \$250.00 cash and awards. All contest categories will be awarded. If in the case of a tie, the tiebreaker will be the contestant with the highest scoring points in the interview portion of the contest.

6. All contestants will be required to submit two **digital** 5x7 VERTICAL BUST SHOT. (Vertical bust shot means head and shoulders). One photo in full color and one photo in black and white. Each photograph must be in "dress" rodeo attire. (NO PROPS, CROWNS OR BANNERS ALLOWED) A release from your photographer is required with your application. Any photographs received that do not meet the above specifications will be excluded from the photogenic judging category.

7. All contestants will compete in each event dressed in full rodeo attire. **All outfits require boots, hat and belt. No Straw Hats during any part of the competition.** Refrain from using stampede strings during horsemanship and rodeo nights.

8. During the rodeo, contestants will be on horseback for the grand entry and queens run introductions. All contestants must have their contestant number and stay in rodeo dress attire at all times.

9. Any unsportsmanlike or dishonest conduct by a contestant and/or relatives will result in immediate disqualification from the contest and all awards. Social media included.

10. Current Jr. Miss MFDR or past Jr. Miss MFDR title holders are eligible to compete in the Miss MFDR division regardless of age.

11. You must realize that if you win the title, some expense will be required to furnish clothing for required appearances. Travel expenses will not be provided; the winner will have a contract to be signed after the last night of the rodeo.

12. All contestants are required to sell rodeo tickets and/or collect donations. A minimum of \$500.00 must be sold to compete for the title. All contestants that do not meet the requirement will not be eligible to win any categories.

REMINDER! ALL TICKET SALES WILL GO TO THE MINEOLA FIRE DEPTMENT NOT THE CONTEST.

Judged categories include:

A. Interview: Judges will interview each individual for up to 10 minutes. Questions will come from the given study packet. With this portion each contestant can earn 0-55 points. The highest scoring contestant will receive an award for this category. For Jr. Miss & Miss Contestants.

B. Modeling: This portion will be held during the luncheon. Each contestant will individually model a western style outfit. Dresses are not mandatory. This portion each contestant can earn 0-10 points. The highest scoring contestant will receive an award for this category. For Jr. Miss & Miss Contestants.

C. On Stage Questions: This portion will be held immediately after each contestant models. Each contestant will individually answer two questions, one of personality and one knowledge based. This portion each contestant can earn 0-20 points. The highest scoring contestant will receive an award for this category. For Jr. Miss & Miss Contestants.

D. Horsemanship: Each contestant will individually perform a pattern that will be followed by a horsemanship interview that will be timed of 10 minute and queens run following. Each contestant will wear blue jeans with a white collared long sleeve shirt, belt and cowboy hat. With this portion each contestant can earn 0-55 points. The highest scoring contestant will receive an award for this category. For Jr. Miss & Miss Contestants.

E. Photogenic: This will be judged by the Mineola Fire Department members and awarded. For Jr. Miss & Miss Contestants.

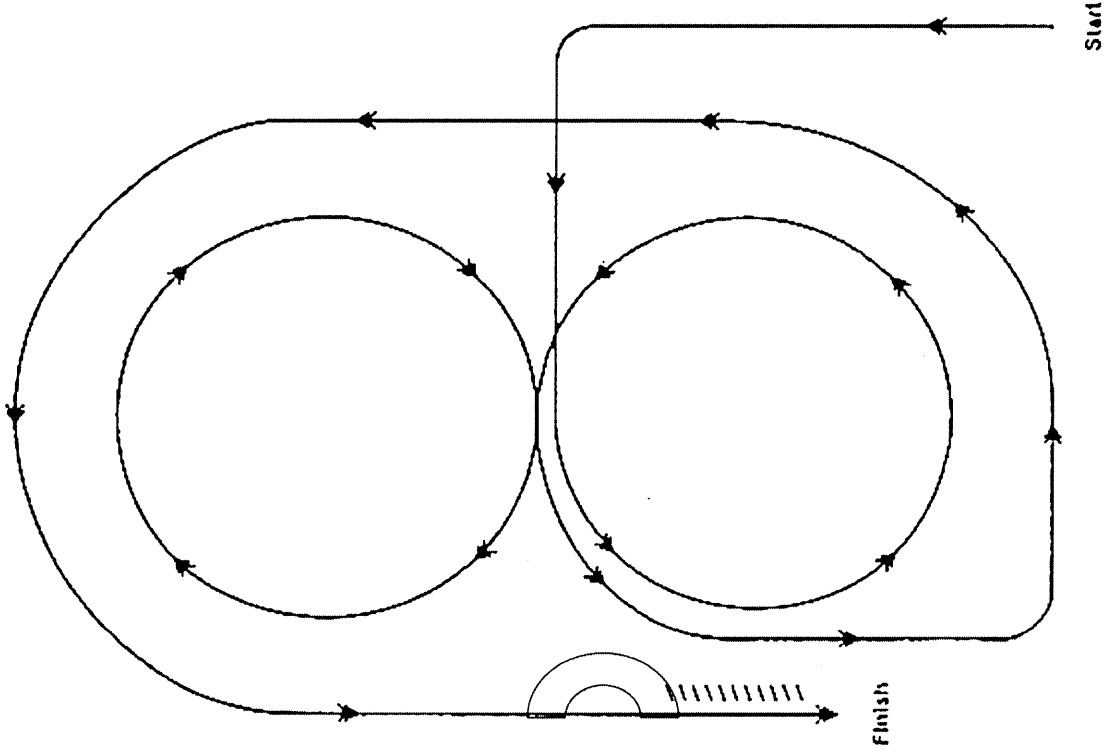

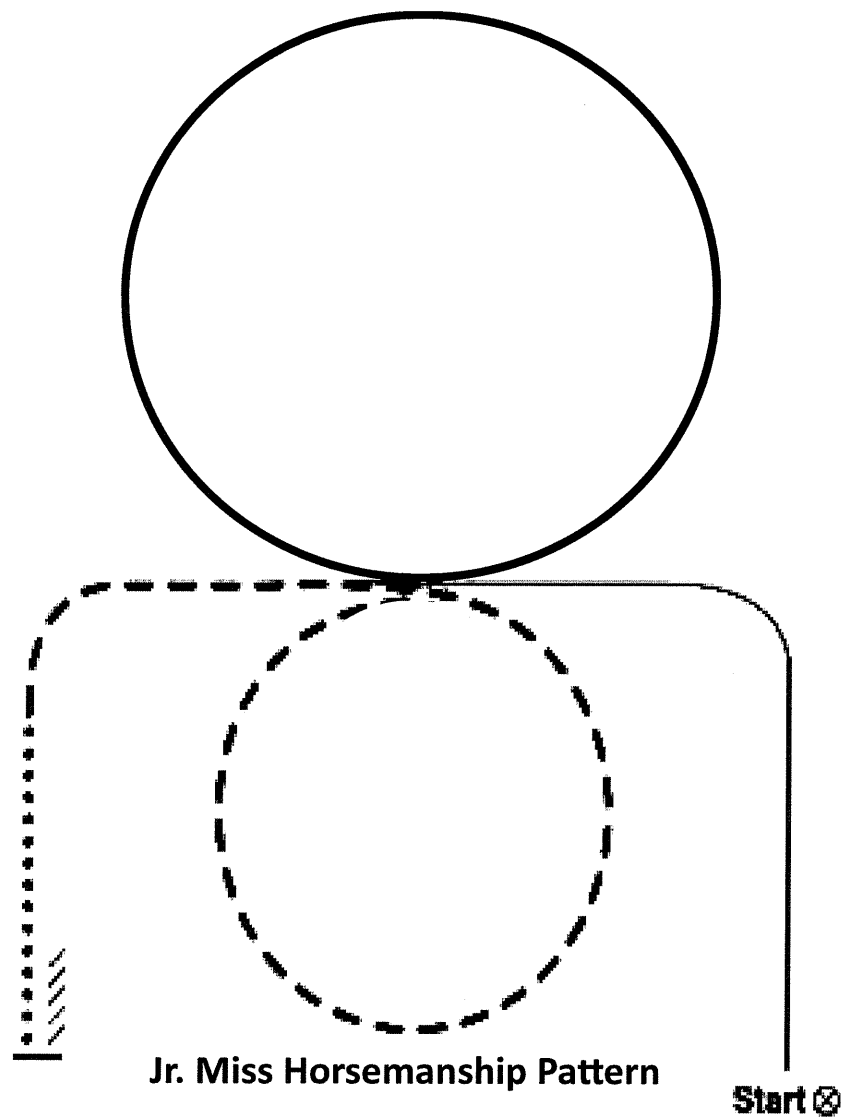

Miss Division Horsemanship

1. Trot to lope down fence line. Turn left at center
2. Begin left lead circle in slow lope
3. Lead change to right lead circle in faster lope
4. Lead change to left lead. Reduce lope speed
5. Follow 1 horse length off rail. Continue left lead down fence line
6. Stop $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way, directly across from judges
7. Back horse 5-10 steps
8. Turn horse left on haunches 180 degrees, hesitate
9. Turn horse right on haunches 90 degrees, hesitate to show pattern complete.
10. Walk across arena to judges side. Stop. dismount for interview
11. Remount horse after interview,
12. Start queens run in left lead around arena
13. Stop at alley way turn and exit the arena





1. Trot down fence line. Turn left at center
2. Begin left lead slow lope in small circle
3. Lead change to right lead faster lope in large circle. Close circle
4. Slow lope down fence line, stop
5. Back 5-10 steps, turn left, hesitate to show pattern complete
6. Walk across arena to judges side. Stop. dismount for interview
7. Remount horse after interview,
8. Start queens run in left lead around arena
9. Stop at alley way turn and exit the arena
